A few issues have arisen. One concerning running time and time keepers. All team reps and referees now know the WNGHA policy so there shouldn't be any more issues.

There is a problem with players in the Rec. Division having advanced skills. Complaints have been made. The plan is to observe a game, meet with team reps, Ron, hopefully Jen, and come to a mutually agreed upon decision.

And my public apology to Ryan. We have changed the schedule 3 times. It is now set. Ryan has helped with it, gone over and above.

Only 3 goalies paid full price. The others have registered as part time but will be playing full time and have paid \$50 each. No one has said anything yet it does not seem correct to me. Consider adding in the policies...any woman who has played Rep hockey, or anything more than Rec, must play in the competitive division.

All teams MUST have a trainer! Between the 2 teams playing, at least one of the 2 trainers must be present in order for the game to be played. Anyone taking the trainer's course will be reimbursed half of the cost (by the WNGHA).

Sandi asked what to do with the completed game sheets? She was advised to keep them until end of year. We can use them to verify results, if needed, and to analyze players from one year to the next.

Teams have had ice times shortened during practices for rep games from other associations. Scott also mentioned that the Zamboni sometimes comes on the ice when the girls aren't off yet, but the girls can't go on until the Zamboni doors are closed. This poses a safety concern. It has been brought to the attention of arena staff in the past. Ron said to document these issues and to let Darren know when this happens so we can forward a legitimate documented concern to the town, if necessary.
