New Business: OWHA Meeting

Coaching clinics:

- All virtual, follow new website, will be a bit more expensive (mini courses associated with the recertification i.e. hockey university courses).
- It's in the WNGHA policy that they will cover 50% of recertification courses

2021 Season:

- Get back to regular league play (RAMP system still set up with old division names)
- Competitive league can start beginning of October, tryouts to start on the 13th of August 11, 2021
- No exhibition games in tryouts -> nothing allowed until the roster is completed

- Tryouts -> anyone can tryout in any association as long as they have a PTS form, have to register through RAMP for each tryout you want to go to

Permission to skates:

- Since there is no registrar, who will be filling the PTS forms? Are they available on RAMP?
- Are they virtual? How will we be doing these -> need to follow up for August 13th.

AOB:

- ITRs have to be in by October 31st, but want as soon as possible
- No games until teams are rostered
- Electronic game sheets, including exhibition games -> someone needs to get up to date on how to do those
- This should be brought up at the coaches meeting need some sort of tech so that players can sign electronically (can be done on a phone or a tablet), training videos are available

Tryouts:

- Have to follow CCCs guidelines
- Currently they are still running on the same numbers at the end of last year (12 to a dressing room and max 25 on the ice)
- Not changing until we leave Stage 3
- Provincial rules -> volunteers / coaches don't count towards the max number
- Parents not allowed in dressing rooms anymore
- Darren has certain dates set out (starting date August 26th, 3/12 hours of ice booked)
 - Kingston and Belleville are the only ones doing tryouts prior to labour day
- Regular ice scheduled to start on the 8th (could wait to start tryouts then)
- Action Item: leave it to start on August 26th -> check in with Ryan to see if he can get things up and running by then
